

Year Long Match Play (MINOR)

Each of the 4 districts of the Midwest Section will conduct their own individual match play. Each district director will be responsible for promoting, accepting sign ups, and administering the event. The recommendation is to charge \$25 per player and pay the top 4 finishers. The top 2 from each district qualify for the Section Quarterfinals. Qualifiers will pay a \$100 entry fee through the section.

Sign ups should start immediately with the goal of matches starting in April. Deadlines will be established by each district director and enforced by the tournament committee. All district matches must be concluded by July 31st with the finals to be completed by September 28th.

Year Long 4-Ball (MINOR)

The year-long 4-ball will be conducted similarly to the individual match play. Each district will be responsible for their own 4-ball match play. Teams will consist of 2 members from the same district. (Should someone change districts during the event, that team will continue as originally signed up.) The recommendation is to charge \$25 per player and pay the top 2 teams. Only the championship team will advance to the semi-finals. The winning team will pay a \$200 team entry fee through the section.

Once again, sign ups should start immediately and follow the same guidelines detailed above on deadlines. **CHAMPIONSHIP VENUES TBD ON BOTH EVENTS**

Season Kickoff 4-Person Scramble -Monday, April 1st @ Eagles Landing (FUN)

Eligibility: All golf professionals, Section Staff, sales reps of the Midwest Section

Team Forming : A/B/C/D: Each player will be designated as A, B, C, or D after registration. Each team will consist of an A, B, C, and D player randomly drawn from each pool.

Format: 4-Person Scramble

Other: Tailgate @ 11:30am

No player of the year points-Participation Point Event

1-Person Scramble - Monday, April 15th @ Sycamore (MINOR)

Eligibility: Midwest Section golf professionals in good standing

Team Forming: None

Format: Each player MAY hit a 2nd shot from each position. Should the player choose to hit a 2nd shot, they must play that ball.



Pro-Pro-Monday, April 22nd @ Tiffany Greens (FUN)

Eligibility: Midwest Section golf professionals in good standing

Team Forming: Teams of 2 must comprise of 2 players that HAVE NOT partnered together for a Midwest Section event within the last 4 years.

Format: 18 Hole Shamble. Both players tee off. Select the best tee shot and play your own ball from that position. Team score will be the best score on each hole of the 2 players.

Other: \$10 Skins & \$10 individual bonus game. Bonus game will be a points only game for individuals. Par=2pts, Birdie=4, Eagle=8, Dbl Eagle=12. Players must keep their own total.

Eligibility: Midwest Section golf professionals in good standing

Team Forming: None

Format: Individual Golf with Stableford Scoring. Same scoring as in past

Other: Shootout following play

Pro Open #1-Monday, May 13th @ Shoal Creek (MINOR)

Eligibility: Midwest Section golf professionals in good standing

Team Forming : None

Format: Individual Golf 18 Holes. There will be 3 Divisions in the Pro-Open Events. Regular, Senior, and Super Senior. Each division will have its own purse and tees based on age/gender.

Player of the Year points for regular, senior and super senior-

Pro Scratch in the Ozarks-Monday, May 20th @ Buffalo Ridge (MINOR)

Eligibility: Midwest Section golf professionals in good standing and an amateur partner

Team Forming:

Format: 18 Hole Best Ball. There will be prizes for amateurs, teams, and professionals. 2 ways to win for ams and golf professionals.

Other: Sunday at 1pm will be an optional event held at Ozarks National in Branson. This is the newest golf course in the Johnny Morris project. 2-person best ball. Teams can consist of a pro and an am or 2 pros.

Eligibility: Midwest Section golf professionals in good standing

Team Forming: None

Format: 18 hole individual pro-am with individual pro purse

Other: This will be a non-drinking event

36 Hole Stroke Play Championship-Monday, June 10th @ Firekeeper (MAJOR)

Eligibility: Midwest Section golf professionals in good standing

Team Forming: None

Format: 36 hole individual stroke play

Other: Side Pot-\$20 per player. Pay the top 5 players for each 18 hole round.

2x2 Pro-Pro Mixer-Monday, July 1st @ Creekmoor (FUN)

Eligibility: Midwest Section golf professionals in good standing

Team Forming: 2 Midwest Section PGA professionals-No restrictions. Each 2 person team will be ranked by the tournament committee. Once rankings are complete, 4 person teams will be formed with the 1st ranked team pairing with the 20th ranked team and so on. We will need to have an even number of teams. Each team above 18 will be on a waiting list until 2 are on the list.

Format: 9 Holes of 2-Person Scramble & 9 Holes of 2-Person Best Ball. Scores will be added together for a team score. Side pot for lowest 2 person score on each 9 holes. Pay top 3 on each.

Eligibility: Midwest Section golf professionals in good standing and an amateur partner

Player of Year Points

- All events will be posted as having or not having player of the year points on blue golf.
- Players will receive 50 participation points in non player of the year points events (FUN)
- Regular Player of the Year Points will be awarded to seniors and super seniors if they play the regular set of tees during an event. Seniors playing back tees can earn points within each division he/she qualifies for based on age

Event Conclusion

- Each event should be treated as a major as far as post golf results/awards are concerned. Give players something to stay around for. Possibly random drawing for a gift.
- Make prizes fun not necessarily trophies and plaques. Winners at Eagle Landing could win a Toy Tank or something humorous. Be creative.

- Have a quick reminder posted at each event for the upcoming event. Remind them to sign up early.
